

MARTA bus route 1

Route 1 runs every 20 minutes on weekdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. The route begins at Arts Center Station and turns onto 17th St. The route turns on Howell Mill Rd. and continues onto Marietta Blvd., then continues

southbound on Joseph E. Lowery Blvd. to the West End Station. Route 1 includes transfer points to Routes 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 14, and 23.

Westside Provisions District
This upscale retail area has high-end shops for fashion and home goods, plus elegant restaurants like Flower Child and Puttshack.

Antico
Relaxed pizzeria with an open kitchen serving crisp, Naples-style pies to diners at communal tables.

Waterworks Atlanta Park
Public park with Waterworks mural and a playground.

Westside Motor Lounge
Westside Motor Lounge houses a full-service restaurant, two full-service bars, courtyard seating, a beer garden, shuffleboard courts, firepits and a vintage Airstream travel bar.

Terminal West
Foundry turned mid-sized music/events venue at King Plow Arts Center, with onsite bar/restaurant.

Goat Farm Arts Center
Huge 19th-century factory housing a cool center for contemporary arts and original events programming.

West End Station/ Ralph David Abernathy Blvd

CreateATL
A coworking space, events venue, retail front, and hangout spot by and for Atlanta creatives.

Hammonds House Museum
Atlanta's only museum dedicated to African diaspora fine art, in a Victorian home on Peeples St.

Howell Park
A small park with a mural by Nigerian artist Chief Jimoh Buraimoh.

Atlanta Beltline Westside Trail
Connection to Atlanta's famous mixed-use Beltline trail, which wraps around the West and East side.

Busy Bee Café
An Atlanta soul food institution since 1947, James Beard-recognized.

Herndon Home
A 1910 Beaux-Arts mansion of Alonzo Herndon, Atlanta's first Black millionaire.

Martin Luther King Jr. Family Home
The house on Sunset Ave where MLK and Coretta Scott King lived until his death, now a National Parks Service historic site

Rodney Cook Sr. Park
16-acre park opened in 2021 with an amphitheater, stormwater pond and bridges, and connection to Westside Connector Trail.

Mercedes-Benz Stadium/ State Farm Arena
Home of the Hawks and the Dream, this state-of-the-art venue also hosts concerts and special events.

Ray Charles Performing Arts Center
Upscale performing arts theater located within the Morehouse College Center for the Arts.

Robert C. Williams Museum of Papermaking
A museum on the history of paper with more than 2,000 books, papers, tools, machines and manuscripts.

High Museum of Art
Museum known for its diverse art collection and modern architecture by Richard Meier and Renzo Piano.

Atlanta Symphony Orchestra / Alliance Theatre (Woodruff Arts Center)
Acclaimed theater company featuring house productions of major plays and acting workshops.

Museum of Design Atlanta
Small gallery space featuring rotating exhibitions that explore the impact of design on art and life.

Urban Grind
Hip coffeehouse with cafe menu & free WiFi holds film screenings, poetry slams and other arty events.
